#### In the News

- Given the possibility of accidental exposure by children, households with fentanyl patches should have naloxone available.
- <u>Drug makers/distributers pay \$26 billion</u> for allegedly causing opioid deaths despite evidence pointing to illicit fentanyl.
- U.S. Pain Foundation compares early draft 2022 CDC Opioid Prescribing updates with the original 2016 guidelines.
- FDA designates a Virtual Reality device & a smartphone app to treat chronic pain as breakthrough devices; facilitating their approval.
- New co-chair will steer NAM in <u>development of acute pain prescribing guidelines to counter the U.S. Opioid Epidemic.</u>

Deficits in knowledge & poor attitudes about pain management demands training programs for nurses with less than 10 years of experience and those who work on specific units with challenging pain populations.
- Darnall BD, Roy A, Chen AL, et al. Comparison of a single-session pain management skills intervention with a single-session health
  education intervention and 8 sessions of cognitive behavioral therapy in adults with chronic low back pain: a randomized clinical trial. *JAMA*Netw Open. 2021 Aug 2;4(8):e2113401. A (2-hour) "Empowered Relief" session yielded a similar benefit as a 16-hour CBT program.
- Kiza AH, Manworren RCB, Cong X, et al. Over-The-Counter analgesics: a meta-synthesis of pain self-management in adolescents. *Pain Manag Nurs*. 2021 Aug;22(4):439-45. <u>Adolescents commonly use OTC analgesics to treat pain & emotional discomforts</u> (stress/anxiety).
- Giordano NA, Kent M, et al. Postoperative pain mediates the association between peripheral nerve blocks & postoperative sleep following lower extremity arthroplasty. *Clin J Pain*. 2021 Jul;37(7):487-93. Multimodal therapy with peripheral nerve blocks cut pain & disturbed sleep
- Sahgal A, Myrehaug SD, Siva S, et al. Stereotactic body radiotherapy versus conventional external beam radiotherapy in patients with painful spinal metastases: *Lancet Oncol.* 2021 Jul;22(7):1023-33. Stereotactic body radiotherapy better relieves spinal metastases pain.
- Korwisi B, Hay G, Attal N, et al. Classification algorithm for the International Classification of Diseases-11 chronic pain classification: development and results from a preliminary pilot evaluation. *Pain.* 2021 Jul 1;162(7):2087-2096. The <a href="new ICD-11 chronic pain">new ICD-11 chronic pain</a> classification system is complex with over 200 diagnostic criteria. New algorithms help classify chronic pain using specific criteria.
- Sultan P, Ando K, Sultan E, et al. A systematic review of patient-reported outcome measures used to assess postpartum pain using Consensus Based Standards for the Selection of Health Measurement Instruments (COSMIN) guidelines. *Br J Anaesth*. 2021 Aug;127(2):264-274. Brief Pain Inventory is the best pain tool for post-partum patients for research studies and in clinical practice.
- Ilfeld BM, Plunkett A, Vijjeswarapu AM, et al. Percutaneous peripheral nerve stimulation (neuromodulation) for postoperative pain: A randomized, sham-controlled pilot study. *Anesthesiology*. 2021 Jul 1;135(1):95-110. During the first week, <u>few opioids & less pain was reported by patients using percutaneous neuromodulation</u> (electrical stimulation) after major foot, knee and shoulder surgeries.

- Ng W, Slater H, Starcevich C, et al. Barriers and enablers influencing healthcare professionals' adoption of a biopsychosocial approach to
  musculoskeletal pain: A systematic review and qualitative evidence synthesis. *Pain*. 2021 Aug 1;162(8):2154-2185. <u>Barriers & facilitators to
  using a biopsychosocial approach to pain</u> are delineated at the micro (individual), meso (service/research) & macro (health policy) levels.
- Roofthooft E, Joshi GP, et al. PROSPECT guideline for elective caesarean section: updated systematic review and procedure-specific postoperative pain management recommendations. *Anaesthesia*. 2021 May;76(5):665-80. New guidelines for post C-section pain relief.
- Chao CC, Tseng MT, Lin YH, et al. <u>Brain imaging signature of neuropathic pain</u> phenotypes in small-fiber neuropathy: altered thalamic connectome and its associations with skin nerve degeneration. *Pain*. 2021;162(5):1387-1399. Feelings of electrical shock, numb/tingling pain & allodynia of those with small fiber neuropathy are linked to white matter connectivity between the thalamus and pain centers in the brain.
- Minaya-Freire A, Subirana-Casacuberta M, et al. Pain management nursing practice assessment in older adults with dementia. *Nurs Open.* 2021 Apr 7. doi: 10.1002/nop2.880. Patients with dementia aren't assessed as frequently/reliably as needed to reach their comfort goals.
- Bao Y, Zhang H, Wen K, et al. Robust prescription monitoring programs and abrupt discontinuation of long-term opioid use. Am J Prev Med.
   Jul 2021. States with stronger drug monitoring regulations have higher rates of the risky practice of stopping opioids without a tapering period
- Agnoli A, Xing G, et al. <u>Association of dose tapering with overdose or mental health crisis</u> among patients prescribed long-term opioids.
   JAMA. 2021 Aug 3;326(5):411-9. Involuntary tapering opioids after a year of stable therapy doubles the risk of overdose/mental health crisis.

- Patient education review of pharmacologic & nondrug methods of controlling pain management during vaginal childbirth.
- September Pain Awareness Month toolkits are available for civilian (including social media posts) and for Military Health Systems.

# Complementary Integrative Health

- Virtual reality simulated walking reduces chronic neuropathic pain resulting from spinal cord injury; with additional benefits noted.
- Cranial microcurrent stimulation helps tension headache patients (20 minutes daily for 2 weeks) when other treatments have failed.
- Integrating a 20 minute psychoeducational session (e.g. mindfulness) into pre-op preparation can cut post-op pain and opioid use.
- Nutrient-rich diets may help those with chronic pain, while conducting/interpreting the research is difficult.
- Virtual reality or other games reduce procedural pain/anxiety (pediatric & parental) and are easy to integrate into practice.
- Reiki reduces pain & anxiety in OB/GYN patients with positive and effects being reported for weeks after treatment.
