In the News

- AMA requests a <u>new approach to the opioid epidemic</u> after a decade of significantly lower prescribing amidst escalating overdose rates.
- CDC wants public input to update opioid prescribing guidelines; The draft will be posted in the Federal Register early in 2022.
- Baby steps amid 'tsunami of overdose death' need to be replaced with bold, evidence-based approaches to overcome barriers.
- illicit fentanyl was involved in nearly two-thirds of > 100,000 U.S. drug overdose deaths, including counterfeit pain pills.
- FDA expanded Zynrelef (bupivacaine and meloxicam) indications to include soft tissue or periarticular instillation for up to 3 days of relief.
- Global year about back pain fact sheets and resources close out this year's effort to enhance understanding and treatment of this problem.

Ann Intern Med. 2020 Nov 3;173(9):739-748. Guideline recommends topical NSAID & acupressure or TENS as 1st line approach to musculoskeletal injuries plus avoiding tramadol or other opioids.

In-depth review of evidence supporting pharmacological, physical, and psychological therapies for children with chronic pain & a need for more robust research.
- Short NA, Tungate AS, Bollen KA, et al. Pain is common after sexual assault and posttraumatic arousal/reactivity symptoms mediate the development of new or worsening persistent pain. Pain. 2022 Jan163(1):e121-e128.Persistent pain affects 41% women after sexual assault.
- Yıldız İU, Yıldırım Ç, Özhasenekler A, et al. Effectiveness of lidocaine spray on radial arterial puncture pain: A randomized double-blind placebo controlled trial. *Am J Emerg Med.* 2021 Dec;50:724-728. <u>Lidocaine spray cut procedural pain during radial arterial puncture</u>.

- van Dijk JFM, Zaslansky R, van Boekel RLM, et al. Postoperative pain & age: a retrospective cohort association study. *Anesthesiology*. 2021 Dec 1;135(6):1104-19. Postop pain intensity decreases slightly with age, but often is strong enough to interfere with activities need to recover
- Gianola S, Bargeri S, Del Castillo G, et al. Effectiveness of <u>treatments for acute and subacute mechanical non-specific low back pain</u>: a systematic review with network meta-analysis. *Br J Sports Med.* 2022 Jan;56(1):41-50. NSAIDs, muscle relaxants &/or nondrug therapy best.
- Lim J, Chen D, McNicol E, et al. Risk factors for persistent pain after breast and thoracic surgeries: a systematic literature review and meta-analysis. Pain. 2022 Jan 1;163(1):3-20. Gender, youth, & moderate/severe acute postoperative pain predict persistent post-surgical pain.
- Fernández-de-Las-Peñas C, Rodríguez-Jiménez J, Fuensalida-Novo S, et al. Myalgia as a symptom at hospital admission by SARS-CoV-2 infection is associated to persistent musculoskeletal pain as long-term post-COVID sequelae: a case-control study. *Pain*. 2021 Dec 1. 162(12)2832-40. Patients admitted with COVID-19 plus myalgia linked to chronic post-COVID symptoms 7 months after hospital discharge.

Internet-delivered cognitive behavioral therapy for youth with functional abdominal pain: a randomized clinical trial testing differential efficacy by patient subgroup. *Pain*. 2021 Dec 1;162(12):2945-2955. Internet-delivered cognitive behavioral therapy helps 11-17 years old children with functional abdominal pain, especially those with more maladaptive coping styles.
- de Oliveira Lima L, Saragiotto BT, et al. Self-guided <u>web-based pain education</u> for people with musculoskeletal pain: a systematic review & meta-analysis. *Phys Ther.* 20021 Oct 1;101(10):pzab167. Web-based pain education provides small benefits in low-resource settings.

Classism in pain assessment and management: the mediating role of female patient dehumanization and perceived life hardship. *Pain*. 2021 Dec 1;162(12):2854-64. <u>Nurses & medical students may exhibit classism biases</u> that affect their perception of the credibility of pain reports & their intentions of providing individualized care; similar to racism & sexism biases.
- Reed SE, Tan HS, Fuller ME, et al. <u>Analgesia after cesarean delivery</u> in the United States 2008-2018: A Retrospective Cohort Study. *Anesth Analg.* 2021 Dec 1;133(6):1550-1558. Guideline-recommended multimodal analgesia therapies after cesarean delivery are underutilized.

Complementary Integrative Health

- Prolotherapy injecting platelet-rich plasma was ineffective for knee osteoarthritis pain and structural changes.
- Acupuncture cuts migraine frequency, intensity & response rate better than a sham method per a meta-analysis.
- Nutritional approaches may prevent pediatric migraines by targeting neuropeptides, ions, receptors, inflammation; & endocrine triggers.
