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## In the News

- National Pain Advocacy Center launched to advance the health and human rights of people in pain, including access to healthcare.
- After years of study, an international expert panel's <u>Position Statement declines to endorse the use of cannabinoids to treat pain</u>.
- FDA warns of serious cardiovascular events and cancer linked to the arthritis drug Xeljanz at the 10mg BID dose.
- AHRQ publishes several new evidence summaries on nonopioids & opioids for chronic pain, treatments for acute pain & migraines.
- Novartis & The Gates Foundation are pursuing gene therapy to cure painful sickle cell disease in low-resource settings.
- The National Prescription Drug Take Back Day is April 24, 2021 from 10am 2pm to educate & promote safe disposal of unused drugs.

- Hunter OO, Wong A, Leng J, Mariano ER. Educating nurses on intravenous lidocaine for postoperative pain management. *Pain Manag Nurs*. 2021 Feb;22(1):94-99. Review of how IV lidocaine cuts pain after surgery and resources to train nurses on its use & know the risks.
- Doshi TL, Dworkin RH, Polomano RC, et al. AAAPT diagnostic criteria for acute neuropathic pain. *Pain Med.* 2021 Mar 22(3):616-36. <u>Acute neuropathic pain evaluation should include core criteria</u>, e.g. mechanism, biopsychosocial features, modulating factors & functional impact.
- Christe G, Crombez G, Edd S, et al. Relationship between psychological factors and spinal motor behaviour in low back pain: a systematic review and meta-analysis. *Pain*. 2021 Mar 1;162(3):672-686. <u>Limited motion with back pain</u> is not explained by psychological factors alone.
- Van Cleave JH, Booker SQ, Powell-Roach K, et al. A scoping review of nursing's contribution to the management of patients with pain and opioid misuse. *Pain Manag Nurs*. 2021 Feb;22(1):58-68. Training & collaboration improves care for patients with pain & opioid misuse,
- Miettinen T, Mäntyselkä P, Hagelberg N, et al. Machine learning suggests sleep as a core factor in chronic pain. *Pain*. 2021 Jan;162(1): 109-123. Artificial intelligence supports that sleep problems are linked to pain severity and disability among those with chronic pain.
- Gamwell KL, Kollin SR, Gibler RC, et al. Systematic evaluation of commercially available <u>pain management apps</u> examining behavior change techniques. *Pain.* 2021 Mar 1;162(3):856-865. Among 76 apps, 28 were for patient use to control pain with quality ratings listed.
- Busse JW, Sadeghirad B, Oparin Y, et al. Management of <u>acute pain from non-low back, musculoskeletal injuries:</u> a systematic review and network meta-analysis of randomized trials. *Ann Intern Med*. 2020;173:730-8. 32805127. Topical NSAIDs have the greatest net benefit, followed by oral NSAIDs & acetaminophen. Opioids are better for pain lasting > 2 hours and tramadol was ineffective for acute injury pain.
- Anand KJS. Neonatal opioids and preschool outcomes. Pediatr Res. 2020 Feb;89(3):407-8. Repetitive neonatal pain/stress appears to play a central role in promoting brain dysmaturation, altering development in many ways & contributing significantly to the cognitive, perceptual, & behavioral difficulties of pre-terms as they mature to adulthood. Opioid-exposed neonates didn't exhibit late cognitive or motor effects.

  common with cancer & is often mixed with visceral or bone pain. Care provided is enhanced by an individualized assessment & care plan.

- AHRQ compiled evidence from over 230 RCT's for the report on Noninvasive Nonpharmacological Treatment for Chronic Pain
- Music cut pain & distress after surgery when used 90 minutes a day (3 sessions) after surgery through 2 days post-discharge.
- Guided imagery relieves pain & anxiety in Covid-19 patients in a, effective & cost-effective manner.
- GammaCore® is a new FDA-cleared device for acute & preventive treatment of migraine in adolescents between 12 and 17 years old.
- Postoperative percutaneous peripheral nerve stimulation to cut pain & opioid use for up to 60 days is being studied.
